NEW BUSINESS:

#1. Discussion was heard on the Safety Grant, to use for a possible 1995 Pierce, 1250-gallon pumper fire truck, taking the speed control units for road ways off the table. John Speeter made a motion to authorize the Fire Chief's to look into a possible purchase. Karen Siegwart seconded the motion. The motion carried.

#2. Information was given by Clerk Siegwart on Early Voting for August. There will be nine (9) days of early voting. Charter Brady, Charter Pavilion, and Climax Townships will hold Early Voting at the Charter Pavilion Township Hall from July 25th through August 2, 2026.

#3. A. A motion was made by John Speeter to promote Brad Welniak to Fire Lieutenant at the recommendation of Chief Poenicke. Karen Siegwart seconded it. The motion carried.

B. A motion was made by John Speeter to promote Michael Flick I to Fire Lieutenant at the recommendation of Chief Poenicke. Karen Siegwart seconded it. The motion carried.

C. A motion was made by John Speeter to promote Evan McGruder to Fire Lieutenant at the recommendation of Chief Poenicke. Ed Cagney seconded it. The motion carried.

D. A motion was made by John Speeter to accept the resignation status,(at the recommendation of Chief Poenicke), for the office of Lieutenant to Tim Pool, keeping his Fire Fighter status only. Robyn Maxson seconded it. The motion carried.

E. A motion was made by John Speeter to accept (at the recommendation of Chief Poenicke), the resignation for Fire Fighter status to Ed Burland Jr...Robyn Maxson seconded it. The motion carried.

#4. Sheriff's Report for May 2026 in packet.

#5. After a presentation by Fire Chief Deputy Siegwart, a motion was made by John Speeter to change over to the 800MHz Radio System at the request of the Kalamazoo County Consolidated Dispatch Authority 911. The Charter Pavilion Fire Department has opted to participate in this optional program. The fiscal summery responsibility for Pavilion will be approximately \$7,454.92, out of the quote that is approximately \$172,154.92, which the Kalamazoo County Consolidated Dispatch 911 will pick up. Robyn Maxson seconded it. The motion carried.
